

# Trans-Ohio



Join us as we take U.S. Route 40, the historic national road, from the Indiana-Ohio border all the way to Wheeling, West Virginia.

This three day, two-night tour will have long daily stretches, but easy terrain. Riders should expect to put 85 miles per day on their tires, and make pit stops in London, Ohio and Zanesville, Ohio.

Our trip will take us through scenic Ohio farmlands, over several beautiful 19th century bridges, and, after passing through Central Ohio, will conclude in the gentle, rolling hills of Eastern Ohio.



## Dates

This trip will begin in Richmond, Indiana on July 1, 2011, and end in Wheeling, West Virginia on July 3, 2011.

## Registration & Fees

The fee for this trip is \$90 if registered and paid by June 1, 2011, and \$120 thereafter. All registrations must be completed by June 27, 2011.

All lodging and meals are included in the trip fee, as well as transportation from Columbus, Ohio to Richmond, Indiana and back from Wheeling, WV.

All trips will be supported by volunteer staff in automobiles, as well as a certified bicycle mechanic.

## Fundraising Goals

Riders are asked to raise \$250 in donations for The Water Cycle Project prior to this trip. However, any rider may set a higher or lower goal if he or she wishes.

## Recommended Preparation

Riders should spend at least 300 miles on the bike in the 4 weeks prior to this trip, including at least one 50 mile ride.

Riders should be able to comfortably complete a 20 mile ride in 75 minutes prior to this trip.
